In collaboration with People that Deliver, Johnson & Johnson (J&J) are giving one high-potential health supply chain manager in a low- or middle-income country the chance to become a participant in their internal STAR leadership development program.

The program equips participants – who are health supply chain managers – with the tools to lead the transformation of their supply chain environment while supporting the wellbeing of others. By the end of the program, participants will have become more agile, customer-focused and data driven, and will have established a robust development plan for their organization.

The STAR program has three main components:

1. Virtual - webinars, coaching, and business immersions
2. Residencies - two residencies, one at the beginning of the program, and one at the end
3. Active learning project

This year, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the first residency workshop will be held online. The second residency workshop is planned to take place in person, in the European region. However, J&J will be regularly monitoring the COVID-19 situation and may decide to hold the second residency online as well. The final decision will be made at a later date.
