Guiding Principles



1. Supporting the Individual

Trained 100 master trainers and 2,000 LMIS users

2. Supporting Groups, Organizations, and Communities

3. Changing Practices and Policies

Affected storage and distribution policies and developed training manuals, user manuals, warehousing manuals, etc.

Sustainable Capacity Building of the Workforce



- 1. Introduced Master Trainers (MT) approach for rollout trainings.
- 2. Developed MT selection criteria.
- 3. Collected 5–10 nominations of qualified MTs from the provincial governments of each province and region.
- 4. Trained 100 MTs from all of Pakistan's four provinces and three regions.




- 5. Developed and provided participants with TOT guidelines for facilitators, a user's manual, training manuals, training CDs, practical exercises, charts, and job aids.
- 6. MTs conducted training for over 2000 LMIS users in various health and population welfare departments.
- 7. Sustainable monitoring and followup on LMIS implementation continues and is ongoing, with the support of provincial logistics managers, MTs, and other government counterparts.











Workforce Capacity Improved cLMIS Reporting Rate






Workforce Capacity Improved cLMIS Reporting Rate [cont'd]



LHW District Level Reporting




Workforce Capacity Improved vLMIS Reporting Rate [cont'd]
