Should we be here?

- Initiative should continue
- Forum for coordination, discussion & experience sharing
- Open membership for countries, and organizations
- Advocate to include key stakeholders
- Liaison within each organization



Structures

- "Organized" but light
- Secretariat with coordinator
- Not costly
 - E.g., full-time coordinator, embedded within important global organization
 - Project based support staff as required
 - Need funding source
- Primary implementer should have a supply chain focus and collaborate with HR organizations.



Steering Committee

- Small (10-15 members)
- Open nominations, decided by Existing Steering Committee
- Composition (to be verified):
 - Coordinator
 - Major global health organizations
 - Private Sector
 - Country representatives
 - Regional organization
 - Non-affiliated



Mechanisms for working

- Membership Conference every two years
- Web platform (forum, documents, newsletter, network, link to other initiatives)
 - Utilize existing platforms



Funding

- USAID convene other donors to discuss how to fund global needs
- Should consider advocating for private sector funding for country and global needs
- Global Fund as potential at country level supporter
- UNITAID potential funder



Country Teams

- Need to keep countries involved at policy and technical level
- Need to find synergies among and within countries for direct South to South
- Country liaisons



Working Group

- Need to determine structure perhaps follow technical lines here
- Voluntary membership and participation
- Need to include countries
- Could be time limited
- Manage or figure out conflict of interest
- Role of the private sector
